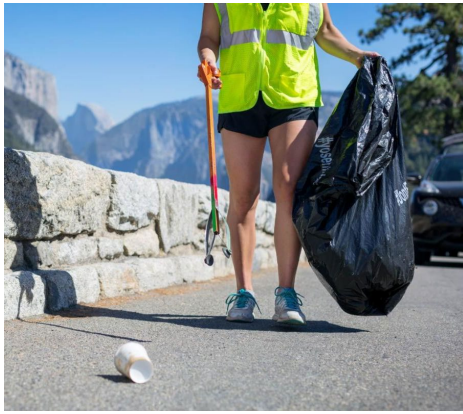

Clean Up Port Antonio
