PAVE Centre Kicks Off Third Annual Entrepreneurship Course

This July, the PAVE Centre proudly launched its Entrepreneurship Course for the third consecutive year. The course begins with an intensive twoweek design sprint led by lecturers Jamie Dickson and Edou Hilverda from NHL Stenden University of Applied Sciences in the Netherlands, along with a PAVE facilitator. During this sprint, students refine their business ideas using the Business Model Canvas and design thinking principles, inspiring each other, building confidence, and fostering dedication to their new ventures. The design sprint also connects students with entrepreneurs and the local community for additional inspiration.

Following this initial phase, the course continues with a five-month curriculum facilitated by PAVE and supported virtually by the lecturers. Students learn all aspects of starting and running a business, including pitching ideas, gathering feedback, conducting research, and refining their plans based on community needs. PAVE Centre further supports these endeavors with seed funding and connections to additional funding resources. We are incredibly proud of our students from this class and excited to see where they go in their entrepreneurial endeavors. By helping entrepreneurs launch their local businesses, PAVE contributes to the community by generating jobs, creating employment opportunities for local talent, and keeping money circulating within the community.

In previous years, two successful businesses have been launched, with two more in the pipeline. This course is offered in collaboration with NHL Stenden University of Applied Sciences in the Netherlands, whose approach to learning and emphasis on entrepreneurship and design-based education make them an ideal partner for PAVE.
